While you may know that you want it to be your people or our people playing the characters, for example, then it becomes about who you want those characters to be. This page outlines some of these scenarios and we can always customize more.

## Popular Choices:

- The Godmother** - Modern mob scenario with the Godmother as opposed to the Godfather
- Millionaire** - A variety of the wealthy and powerful are murdered and their entourage suspected
- 008** - The second most famous of MI-6's men with a license to kill is murdered before retiring
- Golf** - The head of the FBI taskforce fighting fraud in golf is killed
- Wine Tasting** - The millionaire head of a winery is killed
- Life is a Masquerade** - Death at a masquerade ball
- Dude Ranch** - A millionaire is killed after setting up a ranch to get away from it all
- Chamber Music** - The leader of a chamber music society is killed
- Undatable** - A matchmaker is killed
- Always Bet on Death** - A murder at a casino
- Thefts** - We have a variety of mysteries based on theft rather than murder. Just ask!

## Historical:

- Death of the Alderman** - 1920s scenario about corrupt politics in Chicago and the mob
- The Feathersby** - Developed for The Real Housewives of New York, it's our answer to Gatsby
- Pirates** - Arrrrgh!
- Murder at Studio 78** - A 1970s Disco murder
- Death of the Music Mogul** - An 80s or 90s death of the producer of the charity album *Cool Aid*
- Death of the Movie Mogul** - The murder of a movie producer, often in the 40s, 50s, or 60s
- Old West Mayor** - The mayor of an old west town is killed in a saloon town hall meeting
- Sherlock** - Having taught a class on deduction, the students try to solve a murder

## Holidays:

- Here Comes Santa's Corpse** - Our holiday blowout scenario has Santa killed in the cookie plant
- Santa Maul** - A mall Santa is killed and it is up to everyone to save Christmas
- Santa Plow** - Grandma may have gotten run over by a reindeer, but poor Santa!

We also provide mysteries for charities at discounts to provide entertainment for some purpose. For example, we developed a mystery to help an AARP event where a fraudster is killed. The idea is that by talking about different types of fraud in a mystery, we help prevent elder fraud by helping them recognize dangerous situations.
